Implementing Arrangement under the Agreement between the Republic of India and Japan on Social Security

The competent authority of the Republic of India (hereinafter referred to as "India") and the competent authorities of Japan have agreed as follows:

- 1. In accordance with Article 10 of the Agreement between India and Japan on Social Security signed on November 16, 2012 (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), a person referred to in paragraph 1 of Article 7 of the Agreement will remain subject only to the legislation of the sending State even if the period of the detachment continues beyond the extended period under paragraph 2 of Article 7 of the Agreement and paragraph 3 of Article 3 of the Administrative Arrangement, in case, as a result of application of the relevant provisions of the Agreement, the person is not covered by the pension system of the receiving State which provides lifetime payment of benefit.
- 2. In accordance with subparagraph (a) of paragraph 1 of Article 19 of the Agreement, this implementing arrangement will take effect on the date of entry into force of the Agreement and will remain in effect while the Agreement remains in force.
