Procedure of Data Entry Speed Score (DES)

The minimum required data entry speed is 5000 key depressions / hour. Candidates with data entry speed of less than 5000 key depressions / hour are not assigned any marks. Candidates with Data Entry Speed of 5000 key depressions / hour will be assigned a score of 50% (25 marks). The speed of the highest achiever, (say 'x') will be assigned a score of 90% (i.e. 45 marks out of 50). Therefore, to transform the Data Entry Speed of any other candidate (say 'y') into 'out of 50' marks, the following formula is used:

The highest achievers Data Entry Speed of the SSA exam conducted in 2009 is 20223.

The total of TWS and DES is taken for making the merit list for final selection.
